## School inspection report

Generally we are pleased with the report, in particular Estyn's acknowledgement of the significant improvements that have been made since 2013. The main evaluations of the school's work are very positive and we hope that you are able to read each section in detail.

The inspectors have provided four recommendations that the school will address. School staff have already begun this work and we are confident that the necessary changes will be made very quickly.

We are also particularly pleased with the comments made about the children's enjoyment of school and their 'exemplary' behaviour.

The new national categorisation of schools in Wales has provisionally placed Coed Glas in Category B for standards and Category A for 'Ability to bring about improvement'
